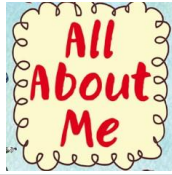




Buttercup Reception Overview: Autumn 1

TALK ABOUT MEASURE AND PATTERNS

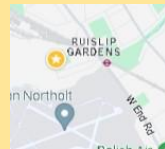
Compare size. Compare mass. Compare capacity. Explore simple patterns. Copy and continue simple patterns. Create simple patterns
